



# Nagasaki University (Nagasaki Prefecture)

The faculty of Education offers on-the-job training and practical assistance to students to acquire a wide range of educational knowledge and skills which are necessary in classrooms or teaching realities.

## ■ University Overview

### ① Outline

Nagasaki University consists of 10 faculties (Global Humanities and Social Sciences, Education, Economics, Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Information and Data Sciences, Engineering, Environmental Science and Fisheries), 8 graduate schools (Global Humanities and Social Sciences, Education, Economics, Engineering, Fisheries and Environmental Sciences, Biomedical Sciences, Tropical Medicine and Global Health and Interfaculty Initiative in Planetary Health), and 2 research institutes (Institute of Tropical Medicine and Atomic Bomb Disease Institute). It is a national university which holds 1,248 faculty members and 9,090 students. Nagasaki University aims at devoting itself to the development of harmonious society by inheriting the tradition of culture rooted in Nagasaki, fostering rich mind among the students, and creating new sciences to sustain global peace.



### ② International exchange

Nagasaki University has 252 partner universities abroad. As of May 1, 2023, 578 international students are pursuing their research goals in various departments.

### ④ Local Characteristics

The city of Nagasaki, where Nagasaki University is located, is situated at the western end of the Kyushu island. The city is surrounded by the clear blue sea and rich green mountains, and the climate is very mild. The port of Nagasaki was the only port that opened its window for trading with Asian and European countries when the Japanese government closed its doors to the world for approximately 200 years. People of Nagasaki have inherited the tradition of international exchanges. They are open minded, warmhearted, and friendly to international students.

## ■ Course Overview

### ① Outline of Faculty of Education

There are about 80 teachers in the Faculty of Education specialized in Japanese, social studies, mathematics, natural sciences, music, art, health and physical education, technology, home economics, English, educational science, educational psychology, education for handicapped children, and early childhood care and education. An elementary school, a lower secondary school, a school for children with special education needs, and a kindergarten are also affiliated. International students can visit those facilities to observe how children are educated at Japanese schools.

### ② Characteristics

The Committee for International Students was established with the cooperation of all the members of the Faculty of Education. It aims to help international students achieve success in their study or research goal. They leave the door open to talk and are student-friendly. Parties, study tours, and various curriculums will be offered for International students.

## ⑥ Requirement for program completion

Completion of one thesis on his/her research topic (or equivalent project report). About 1,575 hours required.

## ⑦ Outline of the Course

### 1) Japanese language education

Students take intensive Japanese language program provided by the Center for Japanese Language and Student Exchange for the first 6 month as research student. Lessons are provided 10 hours per week according to the Japanese proficiency level of the student. Classes are divided into 2 levels as elementary and intermediate.

### 2) Specialized training

According to each student's specialized subject, one or more faculty members will supervise him/her. The student will take seminars and lectures for a year under the supervision of the professor(s). The student must submit a thesis (Japanese or English) at the end of the course.

### 3) Practical training, participatory subjects such as field trips and regional exchanges

Students will visit elementary schools and junior high schools in town and talk about their country, lifestyle, culture, customs, etc. By actually visiting schools, students can experience what the Japanese education is like as well as deepen the understanding of the field of Japanese teaching through interaction with children and teachers.

## 4) Others

Students experience Japanese culture such as Japanese dance, traditional flower arrangement, and Japanese tea ceremony in Japanese language education.

### • Peace Study

Students have an opportunity to listen to an atomic bomb testimony lecture from atomic bomb survivor and learn about peace by visiting Peace park, Atomic bomb museum and Nagasaki Museum of History and Culture.

### • Bus Trip to Unzen and Shimabara

Students visit to see unique nature and historical heritage of Unzen, Obama and Shimabara in Nagasaki.



## ■ Accommodations

Nagasaki University has 6 dormitories prepared for international students. If there is no vacancy, students must rent a private apartment. The number of available rooms is as follows; (As of Oct.2023, subject to change)

There is also a shopping area near Campus and the living environment is comfortable. It takes about 20 minutes to Bunkyo Campus by tram.
